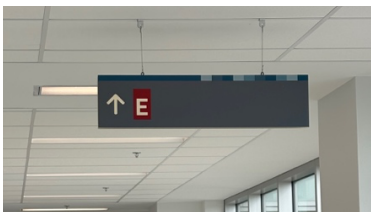
3. VENUE:
