This solution is not compatible with iPads/tablets/mobile phones. It works very well on laptops and desktops. Some presenters will make their presentations only available **after** the talk.

### Verify your Privacy Settings

We imported your information into the attendee directory of the Web App. If your name doesn't appear, it's because you made that selection when you registered. You can add or remove yourself from the list of attendees by going to "My Profile" on your Dashboard. Then go to "Privacy" to update your settings. When your name appears, other participants can send you a message.

### At the Meeting

- Charge your **devices** before heading onsite. The meeting room does NOT provide electrical outlets at the participant's seats.
- **Registration** opens at 7:30am in the foyer of room 511. **Coffee and pastries** will be served as of 7:30am until 8:15am.

Here are the steps to follow to download your certificate.

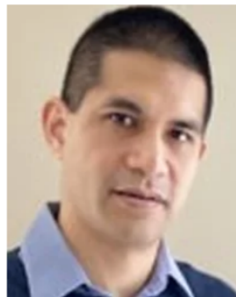
The Specialty Day and the Practical Problems in Pediatrics Conference CME hours are reported on one combined certificate.
